The area The residence is located in a beautiful part of the city with a natural setting yet has the convenience of shopping and subway nearby.

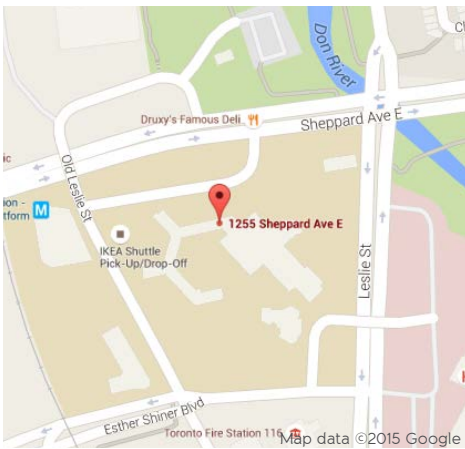

Take the subway from Leslie to Bay station. The journey time is approximately 30 minutes.
